The USDA Forest Service, Okanogan-Wenatchee National Forest in Washington is pleased to announce the availability of a prospectus for a 5+5 year special use permit, for the operation and maintenance of Government-owned campground and day use recreation sites located on the Wenatchee River Ranger District. Applications must be received by close of business (4:30 PM) on September 8, 2008 and should be submitted to the Wenatchee River Ranger District, 600 Sherbourne, Leavenworth, WA 98826, Attention: RECREATION: Dave Lent (Prospectus).

A selection will be made in fall 2008 so that permits may be issued and operators in place on January 1, 2009. Please review the Prospectus carefully. Each applicant is expected to make an independent assessment of the business opportunity offered in this prospectus. Applicants must submit three (3) copies of their application package and supporting documents in hardcopy format. Unless requested in writing to return proposals, all unsuccessful applicant's proposals and supporting documents will be destroyed after the appropriate appeal period. Portions of the selected applicant's package will become part of the special-use permit. Please ensure that all requested information is submitted. Missing or incomplete information will result in a lower rating for the corresponding evaluation criteria.
