Additionally, the selected applicant will be responsible for the cost of preparing and issuing the permit and conducting a Financial Ability Determination (FAD), unless the Forest Service has conducted a FAD on the applicant within the past year. Payments due the United States for this application must be paid in the form of a bank draft, money order, or cashier's check **payable to the USDA-Forest Service**.

Complete applications (with fee payable to the USDA Forest Service) must be submitted to Jamie Kingsbury, Forest Supervisor, Attention: Dave Redman, 2390 Wetmore Avenue, Suite 3, Everett, Washington 9820. Applications must be received by close of business (4:30 p.m.) on Nov. 3rd, 2017.
