The Apache-Sitgreaves National Forests is soliciting proposals from interested parties for two campground concession special use permits to provide high-quality public service in the operation and maintenance of government-owned recreation facilities located on the Alpine, Springerville, and Black Mesa Ranger Districts. The new permits will replace the current concession permits which expire December 31, 2021.

The Apache-Sitgreaves National Forests Campground Concession Prospectus is organized into two separate recreation complex offerings:

- **Rim Lakes Complex**
- **White Mountain Complex**

A facility tour led by the Forest is scheduled for **June 8<sup>th</sup>, 2021** for the Rim Lakes Complex and **June 9<sup>th</sup>, 2021** for the White Mountain Complex.
